HIGHLIGHTS

2021 brought with it many changes and challenges as the COVID-19 pandemic continued to impact library programs, services, and operations.

Undeterred by these challenges, our staff found innovative and creative ways to serve our community. New programs emerged, such as the Walking Book Club and the Spice Club, while annual events, like the Multicultural Festival, were adapted to a virtual format.

Throughout intermittent lockdowns, library services remained in demand through curbside pickup and home delivery. Our Extension Services, in particular, saw an 80% increase in circulation since last year.

This year Pembroke Public Library partnered with local businesses, artists and performers to deliver the Multicultural Festival virtually. Participants were encouraged to watch the video of cultural performances, and browse the online silent auction, while waiting for Library staff to deliver their pre-ordered meal. The event was a huge success, with 275 dishes gathered and 64 deliveries made in the course of 2 hours.
